

Scope: This Quick Card shows how to log into a Wacker eAuction and how to participate in the different auction types.

A) Participation in a Wacker eAuction

Participation in an eAuction requires an active Ariba account and an invite from Wacker. Suppliers will receive an email with a link to the eAuction. If the Supplier and Wacker are already connected, the eAuction is also transferred to the Supplier's Ariba account.



Please note:

In a Japanese Reverse Auction, the price will fall, in a Japanese Forward Auction (for discounts), it will start with 0% discount and then it will rise.

- 1 The Dutch auction starts with a low price. The price will increase per fixed time period. Common are 30 seconds, but the actual time interval will be shown below the current price.
- 2 As soon as the price reaches a level for which you are willing to accept the purchase order, confirm with the **Submit Acceptance** button.

Important: Only one supplier is able to confirm. The first supplier who accepts a certain price level wins the auction and the event will be closed for all bidders.

Note: If there are several lots, the next lot will start after finishing the previous one.

B3) Reverse Auction

- 1 In reverse auctions usually every supplier starts with his own starting bid. The suppliers then are able to bid freely against each other.

- 2 According to the auction settings either the leading price is shown or your rank. The „hammer“ symbol shows if your bid is the leading bid.

- 3 The buyer might have added some important information regarding the items. Please use the arrows to extend the view.

In reverse auctions it is common to bid on several items at the same time. But lot bidding is possible as well.

The auction ends when the set time has expired. However, if a bid is placed in the last 2 minutes and it reaches at least rank 2, the auction will be extended by 2 minutes.

Reminders

- **Important:** Log in timely after receiving the invite:
 - to check if there are technical problems with logging into the eAuction
 - to accept the bidder agreement (no participation is possible without acceptance)
 - to review the auction details, attached documents and requested line items
 - to clarify question before the auction starts
- **Important!** Please always dial in 10 minutes before the eAuction starts! For Japanese auctions it is necessary to confirm the first bid. If you are too late, the eAuction might already be closed for you.

Glossary

Term	Definition
Japanese Reverse Auction	An initial price, defined by Wacker, decreases. The auction continues as long as at least 1 participant accepts the next, lower system bid.
Japanese Forward Auction (for discounts)	An initial price (discount, usually 0%), defined by Wacker, increases. The auction continues as long as at least 1 participant accepts the next, higher system bid.
Dutch Auction	An initial low price, defined by Wacker, increases. First supplier who accepts increasing price level wins the auction.
Reverse Auction	Each bidder places bids for a product or service and bids freely against others.
