The PCF Guideline by TfS is the gold standard for calculating chemical product carbon footprints (PCFs).


The new TfS Guideline for Product Carbon Footprint [PCF] and Corporate Scope 3 emission reporting provides specific calculation instructions for emissions from "cradle-to-gate" for chemical materials. It harmonizes PCF calculation approaches across the industry and is applicable to the vast majority of chemical products.


